Newsletter List: Nicole's newsletter data is stored via a third party company called MailChimp. MailChimp's privacy policy can be found here. **(LINK: <https://mailchimp.com/legal/privacy/>)** Any information that is collected when you sign up for Nicole's newsletter, such as your e-mail address, is stored in order for Nicole to communicate directly with you. Nicole may send email newsletters about upcoming book releases, appearances, giveaways, and other information about her writing and books.

No one shall be subscribed automatically to Nicole's newsletter list. It is—and always has been—NicoleBurnham.com policy that readers subscribe themselves to the list.

If you no longer wish to receive these emails, you may opt out/unsubscribe at any time. Each email contains a button to make it easy to do so.

While these sites often list information such as the number of "likes" or "follows," NicoleBurnham.com does not collect or maintain that information. Analytics: NicoleBurnham.com may directly collect analytics data or use third-party tools and services (for instance, Google Analytics) to help measure traffic and usage trends on this website. This data is collected and used in aggregate form; it cannot be manipulated or analyzed in order to identify individual users.

Cookie Policy: A “cookie” is a piece of information that is stored on your computer's hard drive and which records how you move your way around a website so that, when you revisit that website, it can present tailored options based on the information stored about your last visit. Cookies can also be used to analyze traffic and for advertising and marketing purposes.

**Cookies are used by nearly all websites and do not harm your system.**

If you want to check or change what types of cookies you accept, this can usually be altered within your browser settings. You can block cookies at any time by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our site.

**How does NicoleBurnham.com use cookies?**

Generally speaking, cookies track your use of a website. This enables website administrators to understand how the site is used and to track any patterns with regards to that use. This helps in the development and improvement of NicoleBurnham.com to better meet readers’ and site visitors’ needs. In this respect, cookies are either:

- Session cookies: These are only stored on your computer during your web session and are automatically deleted when you close your browser. They usually store an anonymous session ID that allows you to browse a website without having to log in to each page, but do not collect any personal data from your computer; or
- Persistent cookies: A persistent cookie is stored as a file on your computer and remains there when you close your web browser. The cookie can be read by the website that created it when you visit that website again.

**Cookies can also be categorized in the following ways:**

- Strictly necessary cookies: These cookies are essential to enable you to use a website effectively, such as when buying a product and/or service, and therefore cannot be turned off. Without these cookies, the services available to you on the website cannot be provided. These cookies do not gather information about you that could be used for marketing or remember where you have been on the Internet.
- Performance cookies: These cookies enable websites to monitor and improve performance. For example, they allow the website to count visits, identify traffic sources, and see which parts of the site are most useful/receive the most visits.
- Functionality cookies: These cookies allow a website to remember choices you make and provide enhanced features. For instance, to provide you with news or updates relevant to the services you use. They may also be used to provide services you have

requested such as viewing a video or commenting on a blog. The information these cookies collect is usually rendered anonymous.
